# **SERMON NOTES**

## Colossians 4:2-6 (page 1167 in the pew bible)

# I. Pray for Opportunities (Wisdom in Prayer)

- a. "Prayer is a wartime walkie talkie, not a domestic intercom" (John Piper); we too often think of prayer as a domestic intercom in which we call on the butler to please bring another pillow to the den; prayer was designed for the battlefield
- b. Pray for what? For God to open a door with people (not just to meet personal needs)
- c. To do what? To declare the mystery of Christ
- d. Prayer must be persistent devote yourselves
  - i. It is God who will create divine opportunities

# II. Look for and take hold of opportunities (Wisdom in Opportunities)

- a. V. 4—that I might make it (the message) clear
- b. V. 6—that you may know how to answer...
- c. Are your eyes open to opportunities or do you live life with tunnel vision?

# III. Use Wisdom in How You Relate

- a. Do we even give thought to how we relate to non-Christians?
  - i. Do we take a moment to think what they are going through on a daily basis?
  - ii. Do we think about how they would feel if they came through this church?
  - iii. Our we mindful of how we present the message of Jesus and how they would interpret it?
- b. Making the most use of your time

- c. Let your speech be gracious—non-Christians need to know they are loved, not condemned
  - *Seasoned with salt*—to ancient Greeks salt designated 'the wit that gives zest and liveliness to conversation' (Curtis Vaughan)—It's a sin to bore people with the gospel
- d. Be mindful about how you would answer—conversation must be appropriate for each person we speak to

# IV. What about you? What about us at Beech?

- a. Are you (we) devoted to praying for opportunities to share Christ with people we know, or with those in the community?
- b. Are you (we) on the lookout for opportunities that God give us to share our faith with others?
- c. Are you (we) mindful of the way in which you (we) present the gospel to non-Christian people? We can be bold without being obnoxious; we can be engaging and make it interesting without trying too hard to be entertaining or compromising; we can be truthful yet gracious and not condemning
- d. Take the time to think about how you would present your faith to those around you. If you would like some wisdom or help, don't hesitate to contact pastor Matt, he would be glad to offer any advice
